## England's Labor Party Deals Blow to Wilson's Policies

BLACKPOOL, England (AP) — Britain's Labor party today ends its first annual convention since being voted out of office, and former Prime Minister Harold Wilson's authority has been shaken and leadership challenged.

Following several clashes over policies, many of the 1,116 delegates and party workers began leaving.

Wilson, 55, drew applause from delegates for his keynote speech Tuesday, but endured a succession of rebuffs in the voting.

## Court Rules GM at Fault In 2 Sports Car Deaths

SACRAMENTO (AP) — Faulty design of a 1965-mod-1 Corvette Sting Ray sports car led to death of two men in a fiery midnight accident in 1965, a state court of appeal has ruled.

The 3rd District Court of Appeal upheld a lower court verdict Thursday which held General Motors Corp. liable for \$375,000 in damages and \$276,179.51 for wrongful death to Carol Baderek of Sacramento, whose husband and brother were killed in the accident and who suffered extensive burns herself.

Attorneys for General Motors said the verdict would be appealed.

The auto maker claimed another driver had caused the accident, that an auto manufacturer ought not to be held liable for design faults and that the earlier trial included significant legal errors.

In a 57-page opinion written by Presiding Justice Fred R. Pierce, the court of appeal unanimously rejected the GM defense, saying the earlier trial error was insignificant and that legal precedent supported the theory of manufacturer's liability for design defects.

The GM attorneys had argued, in effect, that an auto maker sells cars to be driven; not to be crashed.

## Fog Cancels Two Flights At Airport

The dense early morning fog that blanketed Metroland caused cancellation of at least two flights at Albany County Airport, which, though technically "open," stopped handling commercial arrivals or departures at about 3 a.m.

A spokesman at the Flight Control Tower said the fog caused conditions at the airport to drop below the "weather minimum," resulting in a halt to commercial air traffic. He said commercial arrivals would be assigned holding patterns or diverted to alternate airports, until the fog lifted.

Mohawk Airlines Flights 400 to Kennedy Airport at 7 a.m. and 400 to White Plains and on to Washington at 7:30 a.m. were canceled.

The airport remained open to private aircraft, however, and at 6 a.m. today, when the fog was thick, a light aircraft did take off from the airport, a controller said.

## Cuts Credit For Frisbee

EUGENE, Ore. (AP) — After the University of Oregon offered a one-credit course this semester entitled, "Frisbee techniques and special implication, 407," about 50 students registered.

Citizens of Eugene began wondering aloud whether a credit course in Frisbee throwing had any educational value at a state-owned university.

University officials then notified the registrants their course would be without credit.

The angry Frisbeists said Frisbee "throwing demands great coordination and aerodynamic expertise and pointed to credit courses for such things as football, basketball, badminton and tennis on Route 9.

They gathered in front of the university's administration building this week and filled the air with the whirling plastic dishes in protest.

## Driver's Death Ruled Natural

The death of a Forest Hills man shortly after a minor traffic accident south of Saratoga Springs has been ruled due to natural causes.

Saratoga County Coroner Donald Clark of South Glens Falls issued the ruling in the death of Arthur Forman, 62, who died at Saratoga Hospital Wednesday evening, about two hours after an accident on Route 9.

The coroner said Mr. Forman died of a heart attack. He was taken to the hospital shortly after the accident, complaining of chest pains.
